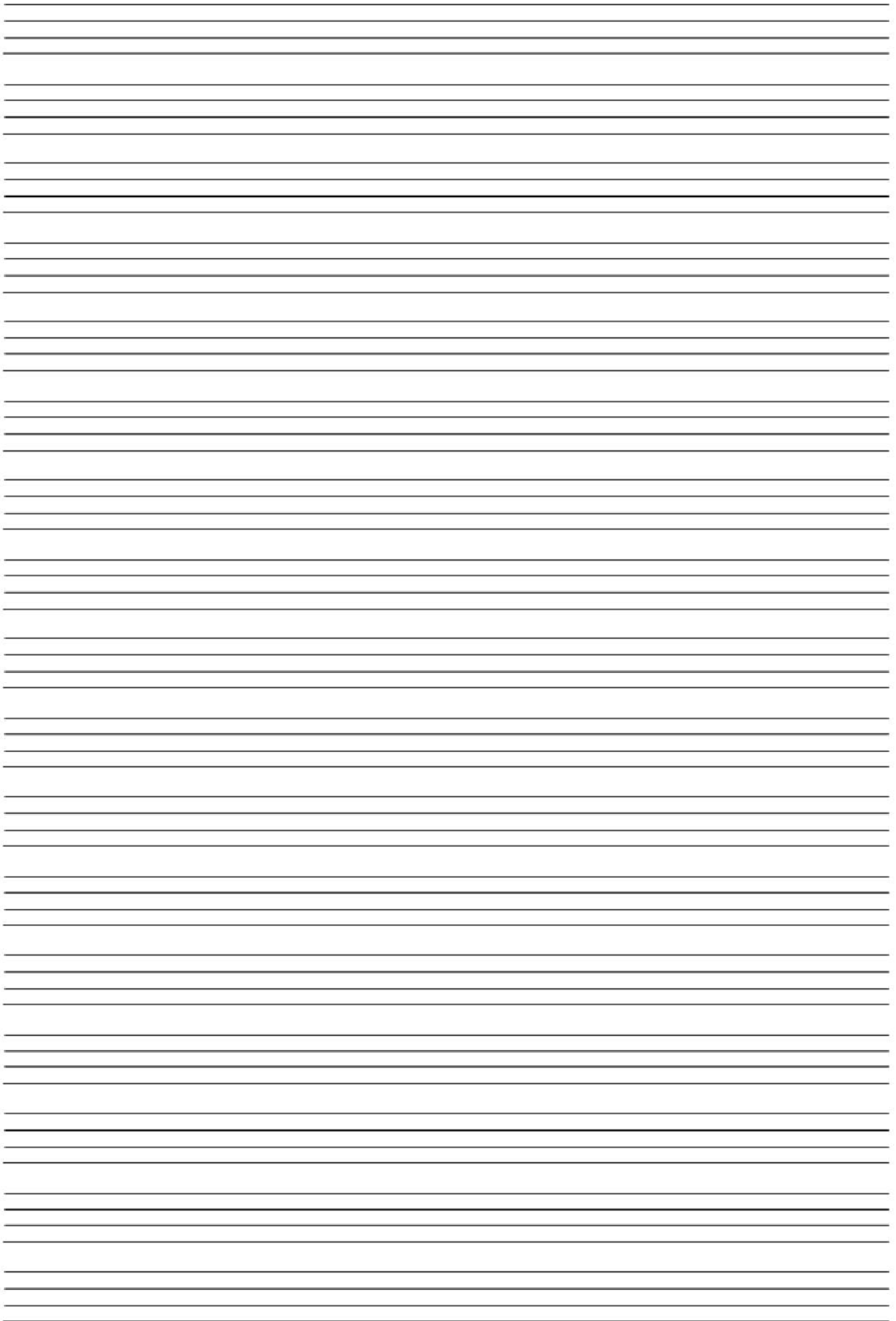


## 短文介绍一部中国好电影

It taught me that true strength lies in self-belief and the courage to rewrite one's own story. Ne Zha is not just entertainment; it's a beacon of hope and perseverance.

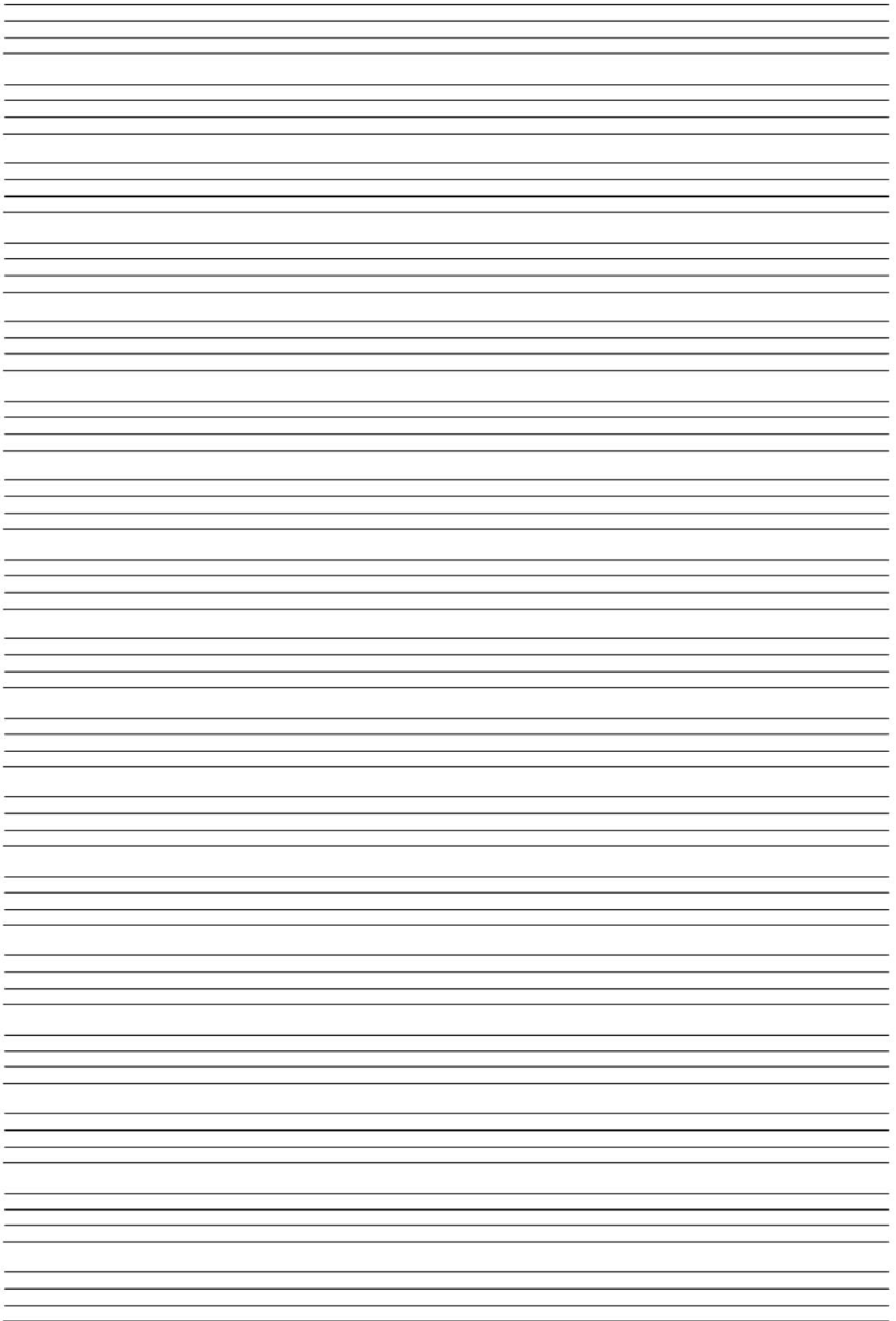


## 通知-环保主题会

Please attend the meeting on time, prepared to actively participate.

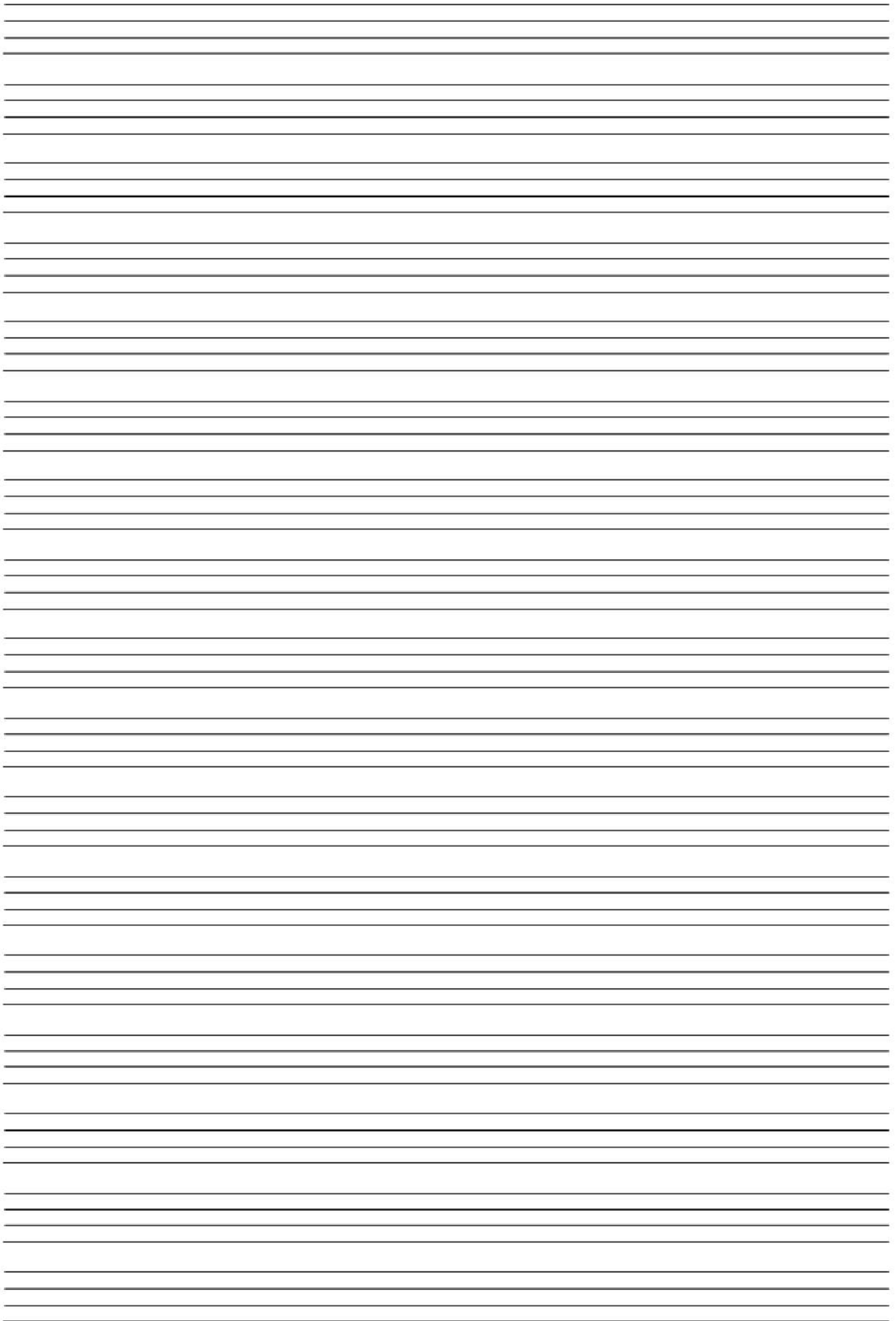


## 邀请参加免费的线上中国文化公开课

We believe these courses will offer you a wonderful opportunity to deepen your understanding of Chinese culture. Looking forward to your participation!

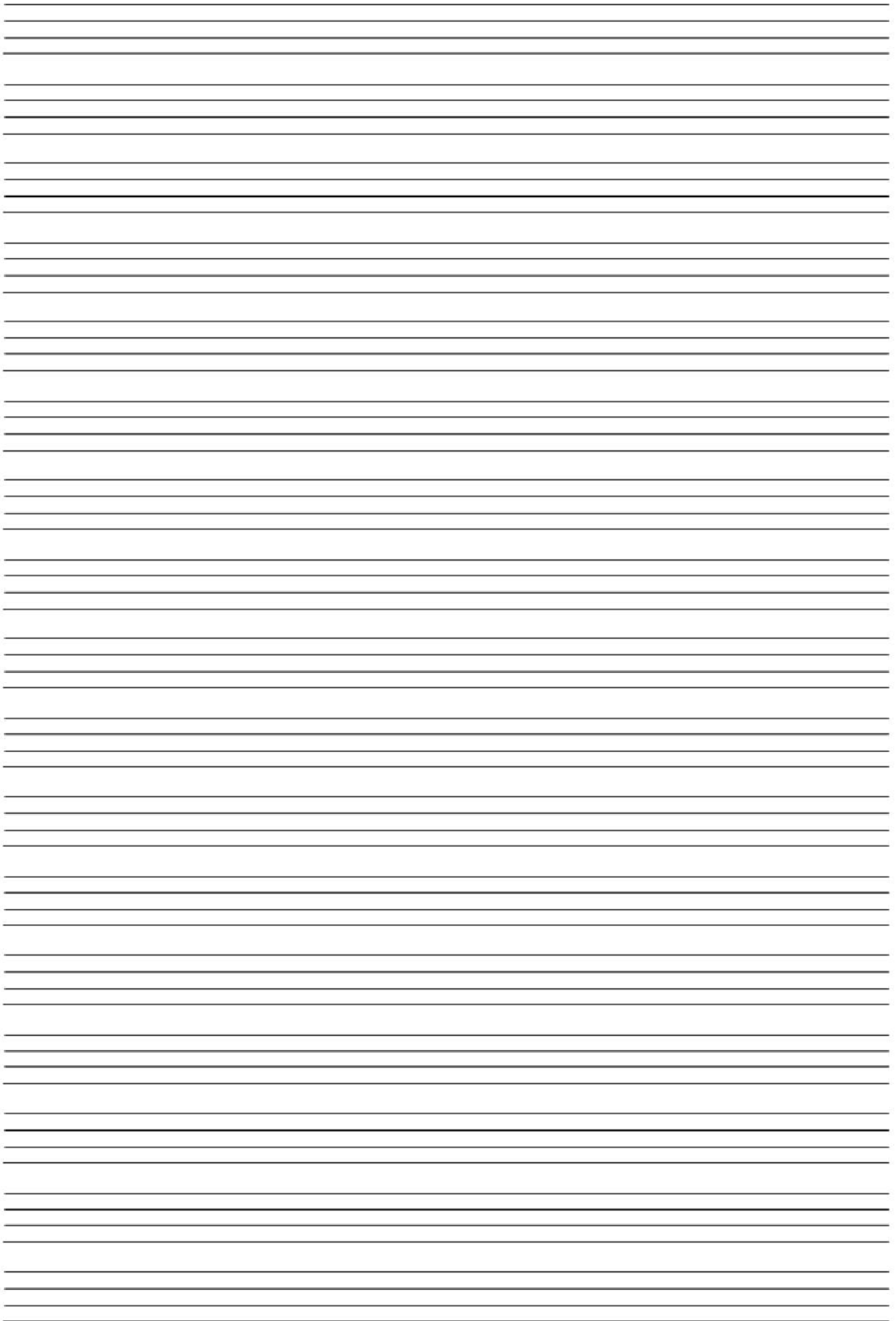


## 邮件-分享高中选修课开设情况

## 安慰考试受打击的 Julia

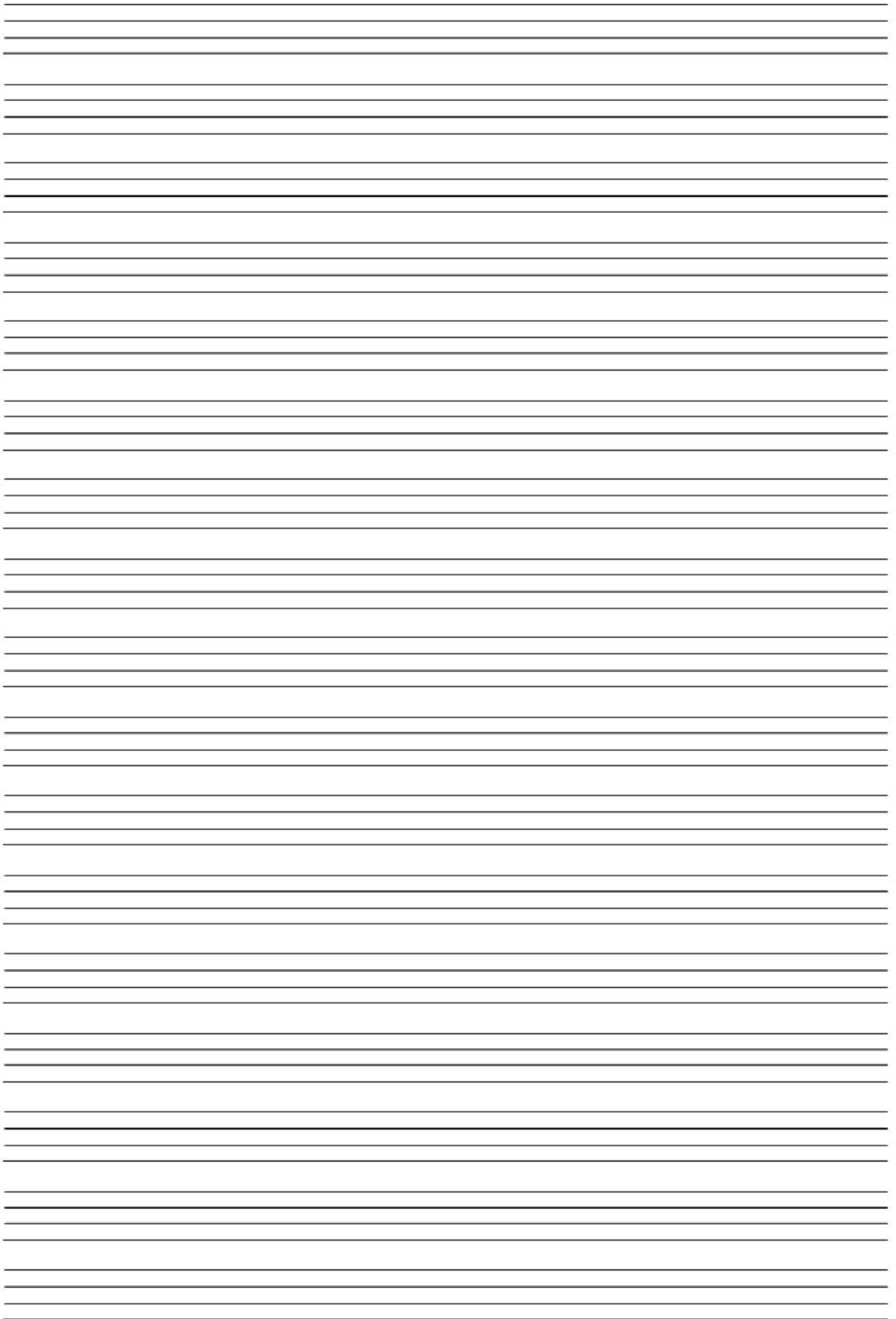
I'm so sorry to hear about your recent exam experience.

Break down your study tasks into manageable parts and tackle them one by one. I'm here for you, and I believe in you. You've got this!

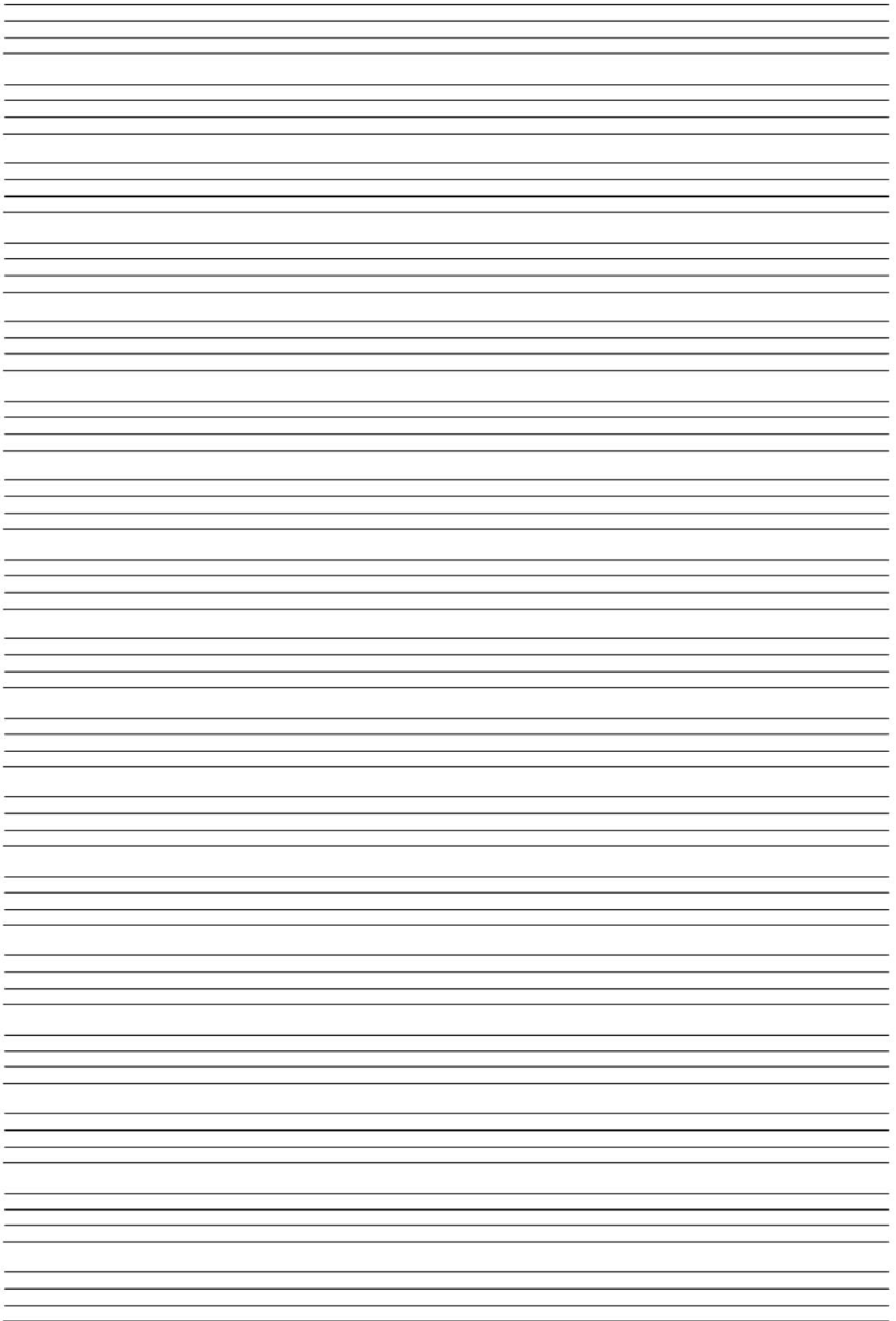


## 报道-春季播种活动

The experience benefited us a lot. Not only did we gain practical agricultural skills but we also developed a deeper appreciation for nature and the effort behind food production.

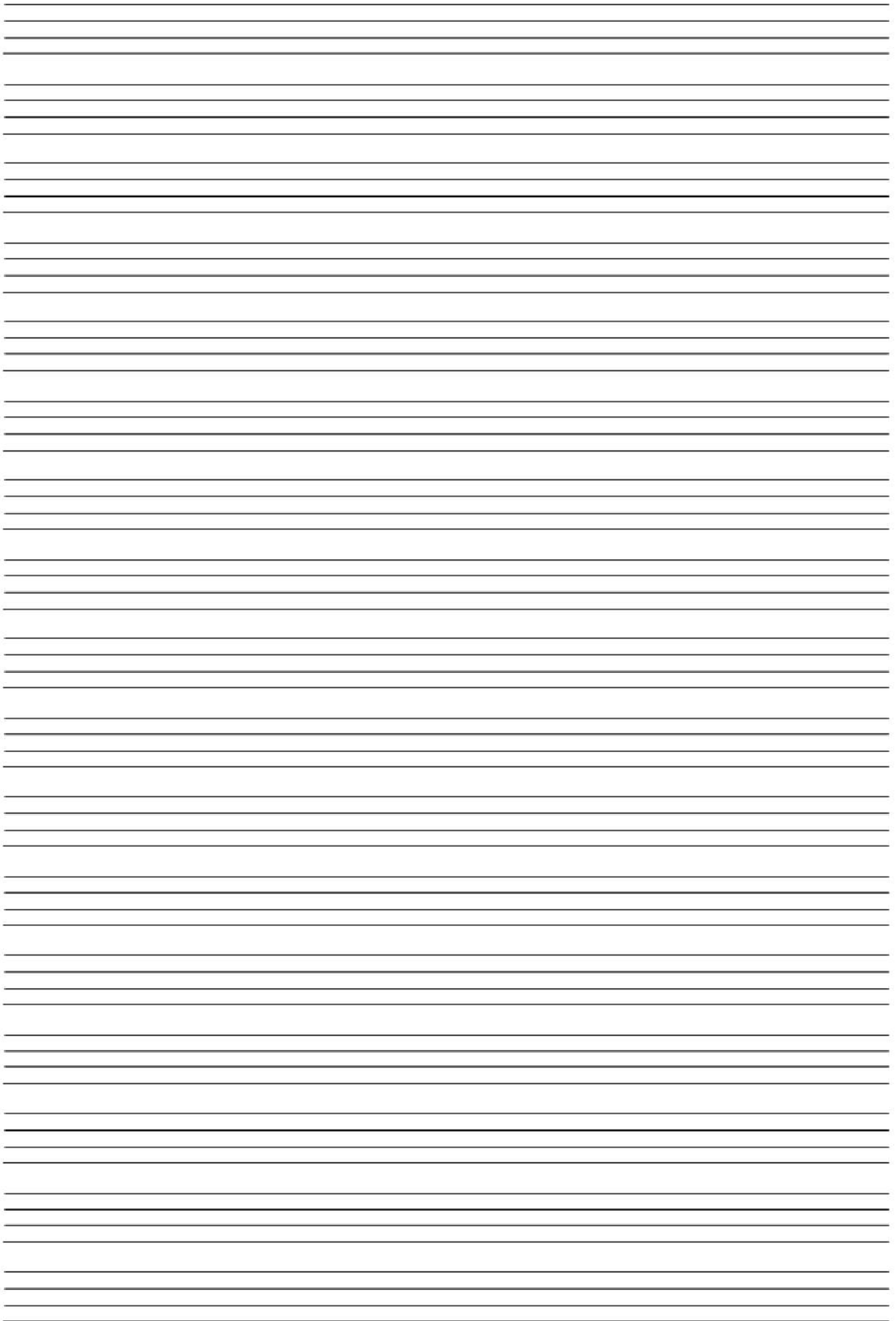


## 投稿-AI 时代下的阅读

By combining AI with human insight, we can make the most of reading in the digital age.

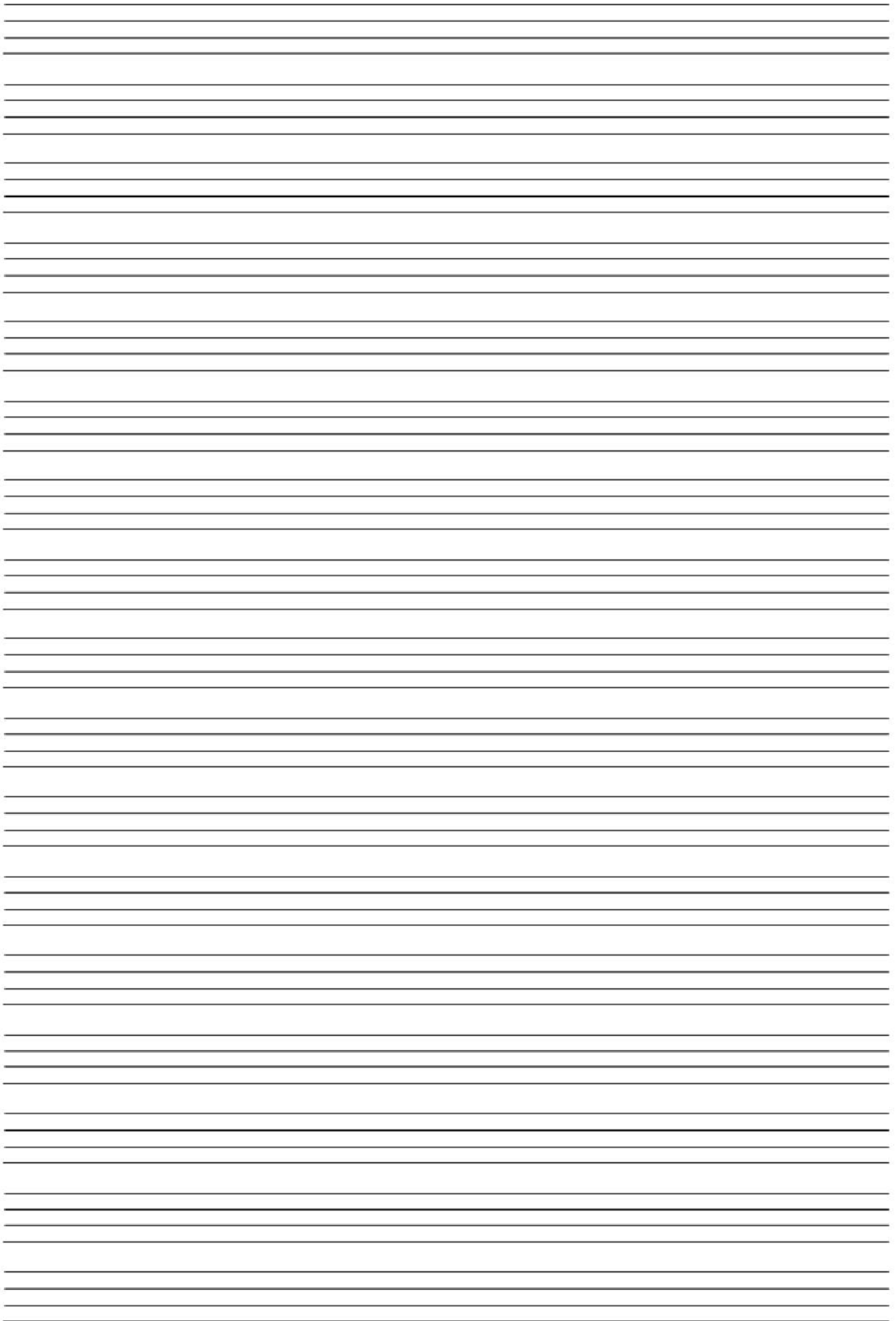


Last week, our school invited several outstanding graduates who are model workers to share their stories.

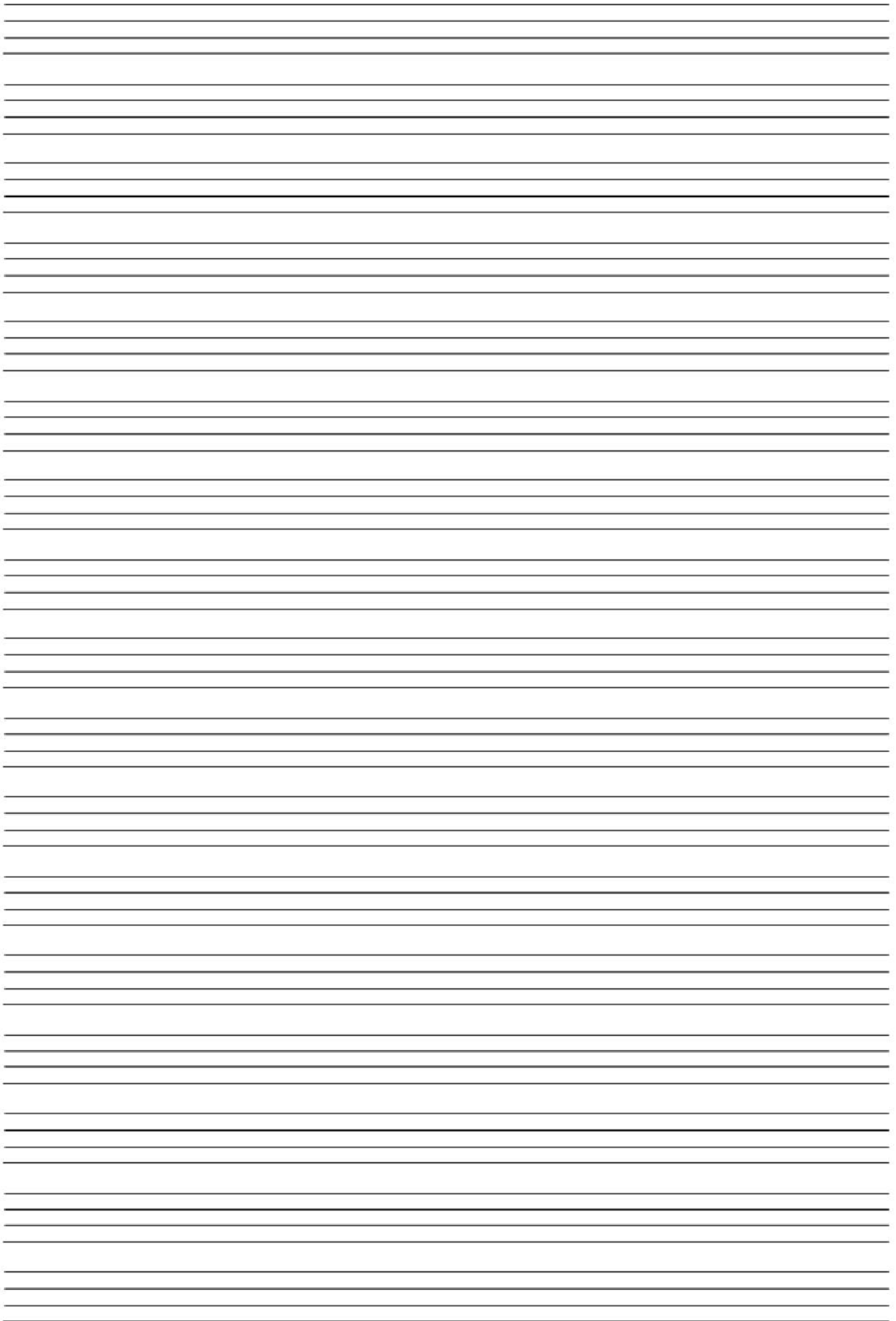
I'm determined to follow in the model workers' footsteps and work hard to make the world brighter.
